The contemporary society is ~~being~~ going through a massive process known as "urbanization" — many people are moving from the country side to large cities. We have conducted a poll to see the advantages of such a decision and its results will be discussed in the following report.

"Better opportunities for work and study" was the most popular option in the poll (35%). It cannot be denied that big cities do provide many opportunities for successful careers, offering specialised education and near immediate adaptation for an average individual. It must also be noted that "Modern conveniences" and "Entertainment" were also chosen to be the defining good qualities of big city life, though to a lesser extent, gathering 10% and 14% of respondents in their favor.
